Wednesday 6th August 2025: Departing Stansbury, Yorke Peninsula at 8:00am (with further pick-ups along our journey), our first day's travels will have us stop for lunch at the "Arid Lands Botanical Garden", Port August, then travel onto this evening's destination Kimba, where we'll dine & stay at the "Kimba Hotel", a Community complex. Kimba is a lovely town and just happens to be half way across Australia East/West. The "Big Galah" & magnificent Silo Artwork will also be part of our visit. (L,D)

Thursday 7th August 2025: A shortish trip today starts after breakfast as we head further West to the coastal town of Ceduna. Along our way there are quite a few stops including Wudinna, Minnipa and Poochera where I've found places of interest to visit but will keep a bit up my sleeve for mystique's sake!!! This evening we dine and stay at the awesome and secure "Ceduna Foreshore Hotel" with rooms to die for!!! (B,L,D)

Friday 8th August 2025: This is the only morning where we need to be on the road earlier than "normal". Off at 8:00am to travel to Fowlers Bay where we board the fantastic "Asherah" for a 2-3 hour cruise in amongst the Southern Right Whales who're inhabiting the gorgeous bay. These creatures are monsters and the mums nurturing their calves are a sight to behold. Mother Nature at her best, again. After lunch we'll meander onto "The Nullarbor Roadhouse" for our evening's accommodation & meal amongst the plain with no trees!!! (B,L,D)

Saturday 9th August 2025: We'll start the day by heading to the Bunda Cliffs where the Head of Bight is located. The boardwalks here are extraordinary and avail us to view the whale population from elevated positions. This compliments yesterday's surface view from the "Asherah" at Fowlers Bay where we're on the same level as the whales. After lunch we'll mosey back past Ceduna, then onto the incredible seaside town of Streaky

Bay. Accommodation at “Streaky Bay Motel & Villas” and a good ol’ pub meal at the “Streaky Bay Hotel”. (B,L,D)

Sunday 10th August 2025: We’ll head down the West Coast of Eyre Peninsula, visiting “Murphy’s Haystacks”, and the towns of Port Kenny, Elliston and Coffin Bay, calling into points of interest (and there are many) along our way to our destination, Port Lincoln, staying and dining at “The Port Lincoln Hotel”. (B,L,D)

Monday 11th August 2025: A day of interest awaits us as we explore this mighty fishing town and its surrounds. There is so much to do and see in the district, we could actually spend quite a few days here but home does await us as we near the end of our tour, Port Lincoln is definitely worth the extra night!!! (B,L,D)

Tuesday 12th August 2025: Bidding farewell to Port Lincoln, we’re homeward bound today and we’ll creep up to the oyster town of Cowell to board the “Spencer Gulf Searoad” ferry to take us to Wallaroo, then home. (B,L)
